



15 REFERRAL ORDER

16 The above entitled action is subject to mediation pursuant to Washoe District Court Rule 53, and
17 the Court directs the parties to participate in such mediation. Wherefore, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING,
18 the parties are HEREBY ORDERED to contact the Family Mediation Program, Phone: 328-3814, Phil
19 Bushard, DPA, within three (3) judicial days to schedule an orientation and initial mediation conference.

20 NOTE: The parties may, as an alternative, agree to employ a private mediator. If both
21 parties choose to enter private mediation, then it is your responsibility to have the mediator obtain the
22 appropriate form from the clerk's office, fill it out and submit it to the Judge within ten (10) days. The
23 private mediator must provide verification to the Court that a conference has been set up between the
24 parties. The Court must also be provided with the mediator's qualifications before any mediation occurs
25 between the parties and the mediator must follow certain guidelines, especially those which call for a
26 prompt mediation process. The Court reserves the right to reject the parties' private mediator and order
27 the parties to contact the Family Mediation Program. However, every effort will be made to accommodate

1 private mediation if that is your joint decision. If the mediator does not provide the aforementioned
2 information to the Court within ten (10) days of this order, then the Family Mediation Program will set up
3 an orientation and initial conference between the parties.


4 Any costs incurred shall be shared by the parties.

5 Where circumstances warrant, the mediator may arrange for there to be telephonic mediation.

6 Pursuant to WDCR 53 (13), any party may move for an exemption to mediation.

7 IT IS SO ORDERED.



Dear Stephanie and Joe:


Thank you for your presence and efforts yesterday in exploring some options for custody and visitation of Anne. I really appreciate that this is a difficult situation with your own circumstances and the logistical problems of travel between Reno and San Jose. This letter is to summarize some action steps that you both agreed to pursue prior to our next meeting on **AUGUST 21 at 3:00 PM.**

1. Stephanie is going to contact the Peace Center here in Reno to determine if that program is a possible resource for supervised visits.
2. Joe is going to seek a referral for a psychologist in San Jose to consult regarding obsessive-compulsive issues.
3. We were examining the possibility of an incremental "step by step" approach to visits; maybe 3 months of visits supervised by Stephanie, then 3 months of visits supervised by the Peace Center. We would need to consider what might be reasonable steps after that.

I hope that we can open up a few more possibilities when we meet again. Whether Joe starts work at Am. Airlines will be an important piece to the circumstances you are both working with. You have my best wishes that things work out with employment.

Thanks again for your efforts in mediation. I look forward to meeting with you both in August.
